IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All classes are held at Genesis Children's Theatre.
- Parking available around the back of the building.
- Tuition deposit is required for each camp/class/show.
- No refunds will be given on tuition unless Genesis cancels the class.
- Genesis Children's Theatre reserves the right to cancel any class. A refund or option to transfer will be given in such case.
- Parents may drop off campers 10 mins prior to class time.
- Students MUST BE PICKED UP ON TIME.
- Actors must ALWAYS bring a pencil, a bottle of water, and their script to EVERY rehearsal.
- Half-day Campers will have a snack break each day.
- Please provide a snack that does not require refrigeration or heating.
- Full-day Campers will have an hour lunch break. A microwave & refrigerator are available for use.

WHAT TO WEAR

- Actors must wear closed toed shoes.
- Actors must wear modest clothing they can move in.
- Genesis will provide all costumes.

HOW TO ENSURE MY CHILD HAS THE BEST EXPERIENCE DURING A THEATRE CAMP

- 3 words: Memorize, memorize, memorize!
- Practice with your child every night to help them memorize their lines and songs at home.
- ★TIP: When your child has their lines memorized, it helps them feel confident. It also instills trust with their fellow actors.

CONFLICTS

- It is very important that your child be at each rehearsal. There are no understudies. However, if a major conflict comes up, you must email or call the theatre before that rehearsal.

PERFORMANCE

- Each Production Class will conclude with a performance starting the last 30 minutes of class. Each camper must be at this performance.

TICKETS

- Each family will receive a ticket code to use to purchase 2 free tickets to your child's performance. You may purchase additional tickets to the performance, if you wish.
- Tickets are available through our ticket provider, Brushfire.
